Letter From Board President

Dear Archway Supporters,

Thank you for your generous and continued support of Archway Academy. Your donations allowed us to continue to provide a supportive sober learning environment that meets the individual educational needs of adolescents in recovery.

Because of you, we were able to impact 106 students at Archway this last school year. **Our 2022 graduating class was composed of 12 students, 100% of whom are attending college, vocational programs, or in the military.** In addition, over half, 55% of the student population, were able to stay sober with no relapses the entire school year, and 83% of students are considered successful in their abstinence-based goals through total abstinence or a short-term slip with full honesty/transparency and recommitment to abstinence (“working a good program”).

You have also touched the lives of 51 of our students by donating enough funds for us to grant some level of scholarship for them to attend Archway. Many of these students would not have been able to attend Archway if they did not have this financial assistance.

2022 continued to be a challenging year for students, and the impact on their education has been profound. We see reports routinely about mental health in teens and how they are struggling more than ever. Watching the Archway staff dig deeper to meet these needs has been inspiring. One of the many benefits of being a student at Archway is access to this incredible staff, educators, and community partners. It is clear to us that the community needs Archway Academy more than ever. Everyone at Archway is working hard to reach more students and expand enrollment. Please think of us if you know of a family that could use our help.

A special thank you to our partners: Palmer Memorial Episcopal Church for continuing to provide us space and community, Southwest Schools for the educational component of our program –these teachers are fantastic, and the Alternative Peer Groups who provide the clinical counseling, family support, social activities, and peer mentoring. Archway would not exist without these partners. We are indebted to each of you.

I personally want to thank every member of the 2022 Board of Directors for your dedication, creativity, and passion. Together we have been able to support the staff in all their hard work, and my hope is that we have changed at least one student’s life forever. Going forward, we are focused on increasing enrollment so we can provide a place for any teenager in the Houston area who can benefit from an Archway experience.

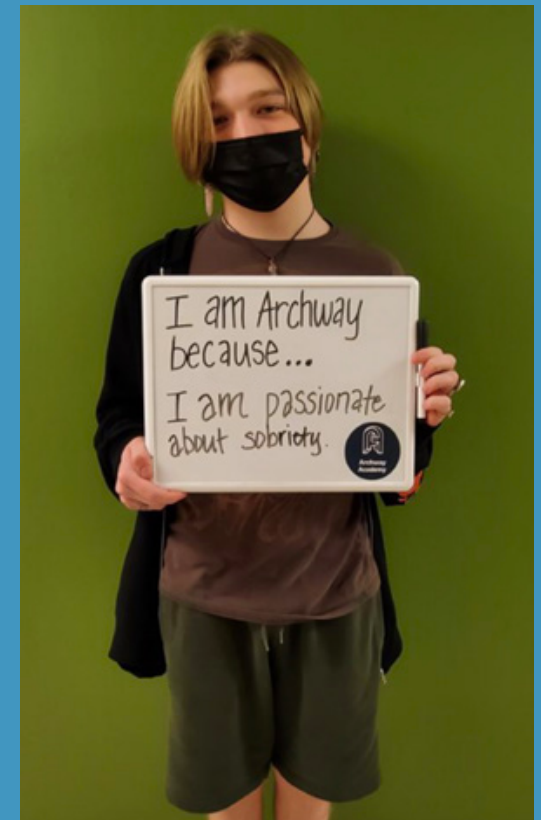

14th Annual Luncheon

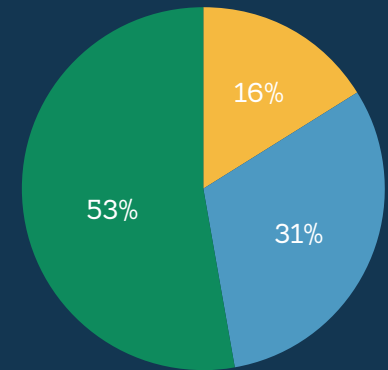

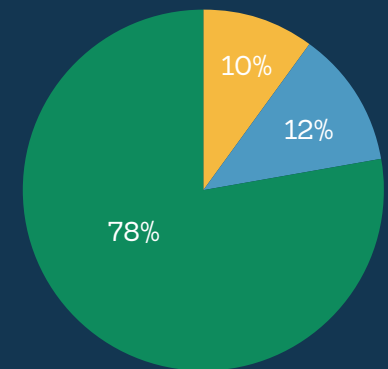
